

THE VIRGINIA QSO PARTY IS OVER, AND THE LOGS ARE STILL COMING IN. IT APPEARS THAT A GOOD MANY PERSONS PARTICIPATED. LOGS FROM CANADA, AFRICA, AND OTHER PLACES ARE AMONG THE ONES IN CO FAR. WE WOULD LIKE TO REMIND YOU THAT THE DEADLINE IS FEB. 15, GO IF YOU HAVEN'T SENT IN YOUR LOG, DO SO RIGHT NOW.

THE "VIRGINIA HAM" HAS A ARTICLE ON THIS PARTY, AND SUGGESTS SOME CHANGES FOR FUTURE EVENTS, WHICH I BELIEVE ARE SOUND THINKING. FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO DON'T GET THIS PAPER, JOHN MORGAN WAKX, SUGGESTS SOME CHANGES IN THE WAY WE SINCE MANY COUNTIES HAVE MERGED WITH CITIES, AND SOME OF COUNT THE CITIES. THE COUNTIES HAVE GONE ENTIRELY, HE SUGGESTS THAT WE SHOULD COUNT EACH CITY THAT IS CONSIDERED A SEPARATE POLITICAL AREA, BE COUNTED AS A DIFFERENT PLACE NOT GIVING THE CITY TO A COUNTY ADJACENT TO IT. THIS HAS CAUSED SOME CONFUSION, SINCE MANY CITIES CAN BE COUNTED IN TWO OR MORE COUNTIES, THOUGH NOT MORE THAN ONE IN THE CONTEST. IN THE CASE OF RICHMOND, IT COULD BE COUNTED IN HENRICO OR CHESTERFIELD COUNTY, DEPENDING ON THE ONE DESIRED.

I BELIEVE THIS CHANGE SHOULD BE DULY CONSIDERED, AND IN THE ROANOKE CASE WHICH IS ENTIRELY SURROUNDED BY ROANOKE COUNTY, WE WOULD COUNT ROANOKE COUNTY AS ONE PLACE, AND ROANOKE CITY AS ANOTHER. THE CITY OR ALEXANDRIA WOULD COUNT AS ALEXANDRIA, AND NOT AWARDED TO EITHER ARLINGTON OR FAIRFIX COUNTY. WE WOULD HAVE TO REVISE OUR AWARD RULES, HOWEVER WE WOULD ELIMINATE ANY QUESTION OF WHEN TO COUNT A CITY, AND WHERE, AND THIS WOULD ADD TO THE POSSIBILITIES OF PERSONS QUALIFYING FOR THE AWARD. THE IDEA HAS MERIT. WE SHOULD DISCUSS IT AND MAKE OUR DECISION, SO NEW RULES COULD BE DRAWN UP WELL IN ADVANCE OF NEXT YEARS PARTY.
