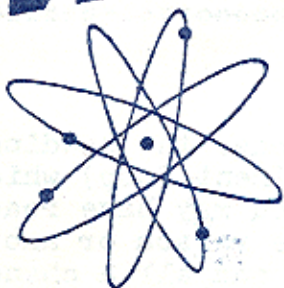

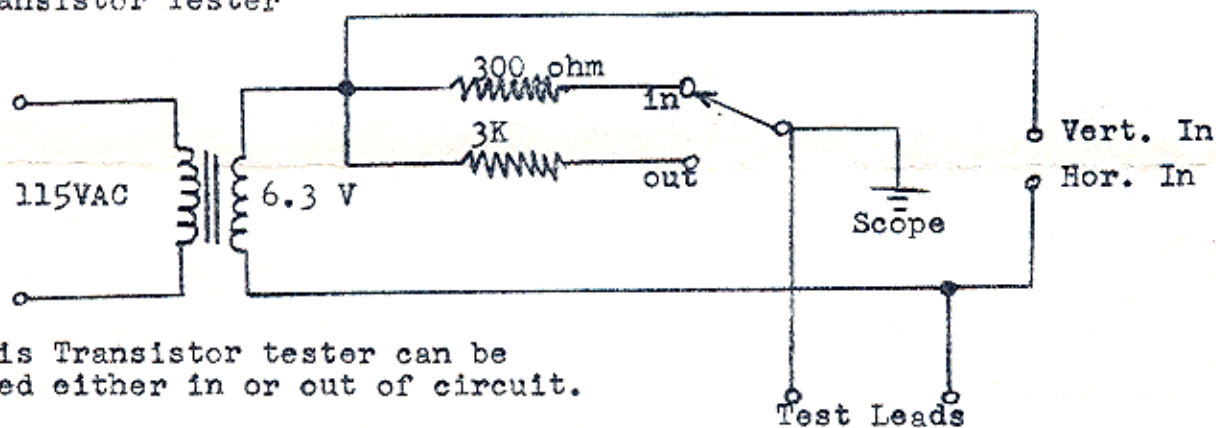
Hamfest (Con't)

Open Transistor —

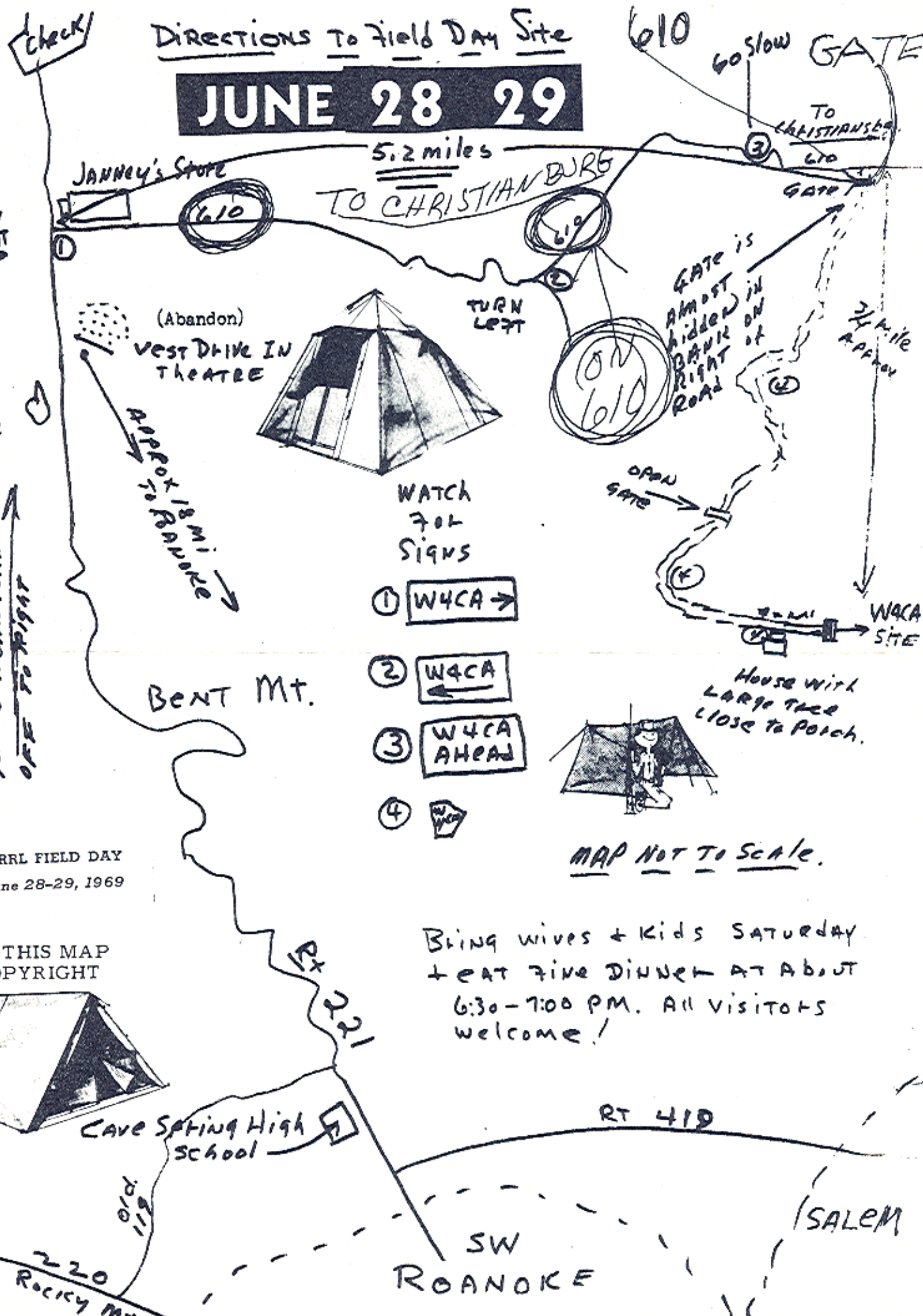
